



Proposition by the Board of Directors of extension and appointment of Board members and Advisors of IETM

Under the current circumstances due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the IETM board of directors proposes an exceptional non-renewable extension until 2022 of the mandates of Board and Advisory Committee members which have come or are coming to term in 2020.

The Board deems this exceptional extension necessary to guarantee a healthy continuity of the organisation in a time when physical plenary meetings of the network are not possible due to the pandemic, and two important topics are on the agenda for the next two years: the new 4-year Creative Europe application and the review of the 2009 IETM's Governance Structure.
