What is the IETM Berlin Plenary Meeting?




The IETM Berlin Plenary Meeting is a **three day meeting**. It is our **biggest event of the year**.



We expect there will be around **600** people at the meeting.



There will be lots to do at the meeting, such as **workshops, panel discussions, trips** around Berlin, artistic **performances, networking** opportunities and more.



The meeting will take place in **Berlin, Germany**. You can read more about how to get to Berlin on **this page**.




It is **organised** by IETM, LAFT, ufaFabrik, BFDK and Performing Arts Programm Berlin.

When is the IETM Berlin Plenary Meeting?




The meeting starts on **Thursday 15 May** and ends on **Saturday 17 May**.




Day 1 has different starting times depending on which activity you have booked.

Day 2 and **Day 3** start at **09:00 CEST** and finish at **17:45 CEST**.



In the evening, you can attend performances and shows happening around Berlin. The shows are indicated in the online programme in **green** with a **ticket symbol** next to them.




There will also be **late night meeting points** where you can meet up with participants for drinks and a chat, as well as a **closing party** on the last night.

There will be **loud music** and **flashing lights**.

The late night meeting point takes place at a **different location** each night, so consult the online programme carefully.

The **Journeys** take place in different forms, such as workshops, performances, brunches or talks.








The whole programme for **Day 2** and **Day 3** takes place at ufaFabrik.

Access Needs at the Plenary Meeting




Captions are available for most of the activities and are indicated in the online programme.

A relaxed room is available for when you need a quiet moment. The relaxed room is set up in the **Garderober** at ufaFabrik.




We have done our best to take note of all **dietary requirements**, but please speak to a member of the IETM team if you are unsure about something.



All rooms have step free access and there are accessible toilets.


What should you bring?

A **laptop** or **notepad** and **pen** to take notes.




A **reusable water bottle** or **portable travel mug**.
